Coach Howard's Career Highlights

Education: Ben Davis High School (1957)
Indiana Central College (now University of Indianapolis). (1961)

Varsity Baseball Coaching: Decatur Central High School 1974-1976
Jasper High School 1976-1987

Coach Ray Howard was a 1957 graduate of Ben Davis High School and went on to play baseball at Indiana Central College (now University of Indianapolis). While at UIndy he was a 4-time All-Conference player, member of 3 Conference Champion Teams (58,59,61) and the team MVP in 1961. In 2005, Coach Howard was inducted into the University of Indianapolis Athletic Hall of Fame.

Ray would move onto Decatur Central High School to be a science teacher and eventually be the head baseball coach from 1974-1976. Then he made the big move to Jasper Indiana to be the head baseball coach of the Wildcats from 1976 to 1987. At Jasper he won 9 Sectional titles, 5 Regional titles and 2 Semi-State Championships (1981 and 1986). He coached 23 players who went to play in college, 15 South All-Stars and 10 All-State players. Twice he coached the Indiana Baseball All-star series while compiling a career record of 302-87, a .778 winning percentage.

Ray was inducted into the Indiana Baseball Hall of Fame in 1990 and also served as its Executive Director for many years. He played a pivotal role in getting the Hall of Fame physical structure to Jasper and organizing the annual Hall of Fame golf outing.

Coach Ray Howard passed away in December of 2025 and the 2026 induction banquet is the first banquet that Ray's hands did play a role in conducting. Our Master of Ceremony is not here tonight and we represent him by leaving his traditional seat on the stage vacant.


After 40 years of coaching, I found myself just one game away from reaching the semi-state for the fourth time. We lost, and as I walked off the field along the path back to the gym, I couldn't shake the feeling that it might have been my last chance to make it to the final four.

The next year, everything aligned. We returned to that same field—and this time, we won. I remember walking down the same path afterward, heading back to the gym, thanking God for giving me another chance. I couldn't believe it had finally happened, and that my boys were part of it. Every player I've coached has meant something to me, but having the opportunity to coach my own sons and their friends made the experience even more meaningful.

"Being mentioned with the coaches that have been selected to the HOF is such an honor. I have been very fortunate to have the family, coaches, players, and parents who have helped me earn this honor. I can guarantee you that, if you ask anyone who has been inducted into the hall of fame, it was not all about how much success you had; it was the association, the camaraderie, and the relationships you had with your players over the year. That is what coaching is all about. I have always thought that if you put more into life than you expect to get back, you will be successful."


